N plug crimp / Item no.: 7721-E



Required tools:	
1 x	cutter knife
1 x	scissors
1 x	crimping tool
1 x	crimp insert HEX .255" (6,47 mm)
1 x	crimp insert HEX .068" (1,72 mm)
1 x	soldering station + solder



Cut off cable tail right-angled. Slide the crimp sleeve over the end of the cable. Remove 17 mm of the outer jacket with the knife.





Bend the copper braid up at a right angle. Score and remove 6 mm of the copper foil.

Score and remove 5 mm of the foamed dielectric with a cutter knife.

Push the inner pin onto the conductor and crimp or solder through the hole.

5



Insert the so prepared cable end into the connector housing as far as it will go (click). Caution: the copper foil must fit tightly against the insulator so that the cable end can be inserted into the connector housing.

6



Cut off the copper braid with the side cutter and move the crimp sleeve to the front. 7



Crimp the crimp sleeve with the crimping tool. This will clamp the copper braid between the connector housing and the crimp sleeve.
